Notes:

CCR - OHA grant not funded, Lee Ann has requested feedback, as none was received. Resilience outreach campaign - OHA using terms like resilience now and focusing on rebuilding relationships with the medical community after the pandemic.

Education/Outreach:

LL&C - Nicole shared about a community event happening through ADAPT, if any is interested in a table at the event. Adapt also has funds for mental health first aid training, if any interest in it. Community baby shower is coming up at the end of April. Free books at the Roseburg Library. Very excited about the next LL&C, will have a panel style of LGBTQIA+ individuals, where we ask how we can support folks in our community more.

Training Team: Looking at dates in June & July for the Summer Training Retreat, hosted by CCR. The goal for this retreat is to bring all partners together in person to review updates to core Understanding ACEs curriculum and build relationships across the region.

Suicide Prevention Training; looking for train the trainers to help train in the community. This is a very vulnerable training and individuals who participate may need to take some time to recoup.

Child Abuse Prevention Month: Happy Health Kids Day is April 28th. Fair Style event with booths and prizes. Law Enforcements w/ HumVees, K9, and Hawaiian shaved ice will all be present at this event.

Celebrate Children day at Wildlife Safari on April 30th. 24 partnered agencies, approx 2-3k individuals, free hands on activities at each booth, door prizes. Each agency provides a basket.

STEAM Extravaganza: May 14th 10am - 3pm at UCC campus. This event highlights what STEAM is all about. Lee Ann asked about putting together a CCR collaborative booth for the event to have all the agency's resources available to provide family resilience resources.
